TOWN OF LUMSDEN BYLAW 06-2012

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Town of Lumsden in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

a) This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".

2. **DEFINITIONS**

a) "Municipality" means the Town of Lumsden.

3. EXCEPTION

a) Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.

4. PENALTY

Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:

- in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and,
 in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
- b) in the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.

5. REPEAL OF BYLAWS

a) That Bylaw No. 10-85 is hereby repealed.

6. COMING INTO FORCE

a) This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the final day of its passing.
