A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW No. 14-2002, THE BASIC PLANNING STATEMENT

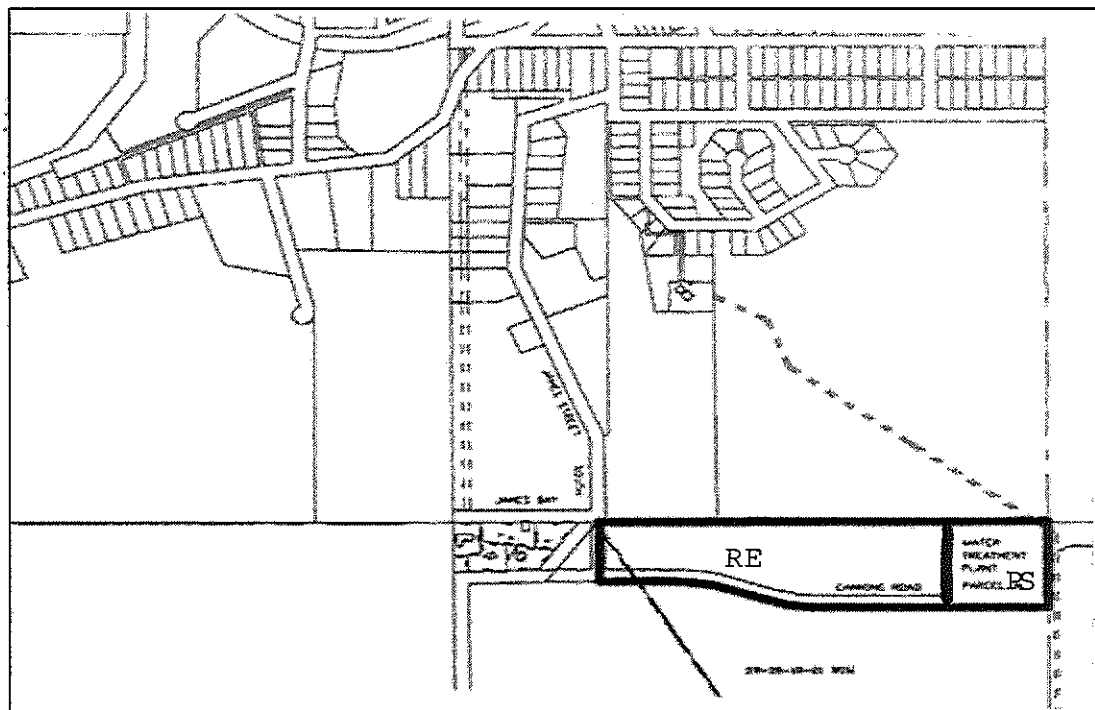
The Council of the Town of Lumsden in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

1) AUTHORITY

Pursuant to section 44 of the Planning and Development Act, 1983, the Council of the Town of Lumsden, in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby amends the original Basic Planning Statement Bylaw No. 14-2002 by enacting this bylaw:

2) MAP CHANGE – GUY and LORINDA JOHNS LAND

The Basic Planning Statement Land Usage Strategy Map referred to in section 13.1 of Bylaw No. 14-2002, the Town's Basic Planning Statement (BPS), is amended by changing the subject property in the SW 28-19-21-W2 as detailed below, from "V" Valley Development District as shown on Plan Maps 1.00 and 1.01 (in the Town's BPS) to "RE" "Residential" land use category and changing Parcel A, to "PS" "Public Service" land use category.



3) REPEAL OF BYLAW

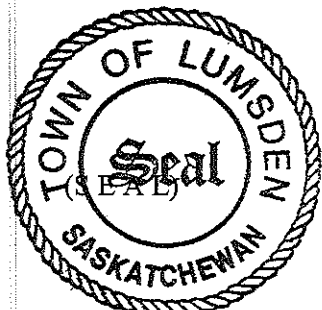
Bylaw 6-2004 is hereby repealed
