TOWN OF LUMSDEN

Bylaw No. 2020-07

A Bylaw to regulate and control the use of Mobile Food Trucks, Mobile Food Trailers, and Mobile Food Carts in the Town of Lumsden.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Clause 8(1)(h) of *The Municipalities Act*, a municipality is authorized to make bylaws respecting businesses, business activities and persons engaged in business;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Lumsden, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. SHORT TITLE

a) This Bylaw may be cited as the "Mobile Food Vehicle Bylaw".

2. **DEFINITIONS**

- a) "Community Event" means any one time or re-occurring public or private event, gathering, festival, exposition, or similar activity.
- b) "Mobile Food Cart" means a self-contained unit to cook, prepare, and/or serve food.
- c) "Mobile Food Trailer" means a non-motorized, self-contained unit that is towed by a vehicle to cook, prepare, and/or serve food.
- d) "Mobile Food Truck" means a motorized, mobile, self-contained vehicle equipped to cook, prepare, and/or serve food, and does not include trailers or carts.
- e) "Mobile Food Vendor" means any person(s) who owns and/or operates a mobile food truck, trailer, or cart.

3. GENERAL RULES

a) All Mobile Food Vehicles including trucks, trailers, and carts shall be prohibited from operating within the Town of Lumsden at all times, except when operating at an established community event.

4. PENALTY

a) Any person who contravenes the provisions of this Bylaw or fails to comply therewith, or with any notice given thereunder, is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of this Municipality.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE OF BYLAW

This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of adoption by the Town of Lumsden Council.
