BYLAW NO. 3/91

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LUMSDEN RESPECTING FIREWORKS

The Council of the Town of Lumsden in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

DEFINITIONS

- 1. In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires, the expression:
- (a) "fireworks" shall be deemed to include rockets, Roman candles, sparklers and other pyrotechnics of all descriptions and also including the singular thereof;
- (b) "firecrackers" shall include any article containing a combustible or explosive substance or combination of substances prepared for, capable of, or discharged for, the purpose of producing an explosion without any pyrotechnical display and shall include cannon crackers, firecrackers, mines, squibs and torpedoes;
- (c) "fireworks display" shall mean a display of fireworks for the entertainment of the public at large;

PROHIBITION

2. No person shall set off any firecrackers or rockets in the Town of Lumsden at any time whatsoever, provided that this section shall not apply to a fireworks display.

DISPLAYS

- 3. (a) A fireworks display may only be held at the discretion of the Council of the Town of Lumsden and under the supervision of a fit and competent person.
 - (b) A fireworks display shall be held only in public parks and other public places approved from time to time by resolution of Council.

PENALTY

4. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw of the Town.
