How does it work?

The Seniors Home Security Program has a list of approved service providers who will perform a safety assessment of your home. If you need them, the service provider can install the following home security improvements:

- Deadbolts
- Door viewers
- Smoke alarms
- Carbon monoxide alarms
- Smoke alarm batteries

Both the service provider's safety assessment and the safety equipment installed in your home are free!

The service provider will leave you with an envelope that has a checklist of all the security items installed in your home during the visit. The envelope also contains the equipment warranties and contact information if you need more information or want to ask questions.

The safety assessment may reveal other safety issues not covered by this program. You can have this work done at your cost or refer to other government programs you might be eligible for.

You pay nothing for the additional peace of mind.

# What is the Seniors Home Security Program?

The Seniors Home Security Program is a safety program implemented by the Government of Saskatchewan. The program supports low-income seniors and seniors who have been the victim of a break and enter or home invasion. The program provides free safety assessments to seniors and free installation of home safety improvements, to increase the safety of their homes. Security equipment is provided and installed at no charge. Both seniors who own their own home and seniors who are renters are able to apply to the program.



# Who is eligible for home security improvements under the program?

You are eligible for home security improvements under the Seniors Home Security Program if you are a home owner or renter age 65+ and:

- Your annual household net income is \$ 35,000\* or less.
- You've been the victim of a break and enter or a home invasion.

\*Program eligibility income levels are set according to the provincial government's housing income levels and may be subject to change.

# How do I apply?

An application form is attached to this brochure and a handy return postage paid envelope is included in this package. To apply, fill out the application form and consent letter and include a copy of your most recent Canada Revenue Agency notice of assessment and return all three to us in the return postage paid envelope.

Upon your approval for a home safety assessment, a member of the Seniors Home Security Program staff will contact you with your service provider information. Simply contact that service provider and set up an appointment that is mutually convenient for your assessment. At the same time, they will install the security equipment that you have been approved for by the program – **at no cost to you.**
