TOWN OF LUMSDEN BYLAW No. 3-2004

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF LUMSDEN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A ROAD

WHEREAS Section 156 of The Urban Municipality Act, 1984 allows a municipality to permanently close any street or lane vested in the Crown with the prior written consent of the Minister of Highways and Transportation AND after having given the public notice of the proposed closure;

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Highways and Transportation has consented to AND Council has given the required public notice of the proposed closure;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Lumsden in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby enacts as follows:

1) To permanently close the following public highway described as:

All that Portion of Roadway, Plan 86R09125, Lying North of a line joining the Southeast corner of Lot 5, Block A, Plan 98R25424(1) and the Northwest corner of Canning Road, Plan 101238612.

- 2) That the Administrator undertake such other things necessary to effect the intent of this Bylaw.
- 3) This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the date adopted by Council.
