



Full-Time, Permanent Equipment Operator

The Town of Lumsden is accepting applications for the position of Full-Time, Permanent Equipment Operator to commence as soon as possible.

The successful applicant must be able to work with minimal supervision. The position requires the safe operation and knowledge of servicing small equipment. Applicants must have at least a Class 5 Driver's License and must obtain a Class 3 License within the first year of employment. A Grade 12 Diploma is required as well as good communication and organizational skills. Duties include but are not limited to: solid waste collection, landfill maintenance, general labour, installing signs, street and park maintenance, campground and playgrounds maintenance, grass mowing and other tasks as directed.

Preference will be given to those who reside locally and have mechanical skills. The wage ranges from \$22.96 - \$34.03 and is based on experience and qualifications. MEPP (Municipal Employees' Pension Plan) and full benefits are available. Hours of work are 7:00 am - 4:00 pm (40 hours paid per week) with a 30-minute unpaid lunch break plus 30 minutes banked toward one Earned Day Off every three weeks. You can expect weekend on-call responsibilities every 6-7 weeks. Applicants will be required to provide a Criminal Record Check as the hiring process progresses.
